# Lessons from Medellín: Urbanism and Mobility

The recognition of the city of Medellín (Colombia) as an Urban Example has been result of several political processes and strategies during the last 20 years focusing in providing basic utilities, public space infrastructure, upgrading slums in the aim that architecture and urbanism were vectors of a deep social transformation.

In 2004 the construction of the *Metrocable* (cable cars) represented a breakthrough public mobility as it was the first city in the world to use the aerial cable-cars technology for public mass transport exclusively aimed at low-income populations. This became a milestone in the social regeneration of Medellín, and also a sense that they have helped revalue the violence and poverty in the eyes of residents and a growing number of tourists.
